PROPER DRESS-

It is expected that Members and their Invited Guests will dress in a manner befitting the surroundings and atmosphere provided at the club. Gentlemen and Ladies are expected to dress in a fashion compatible with the appropriate occasion.

GENERAL GUIDELINES - GOLF COURSE

- FOOTWEAR
 - Golf shoes with soft spikes or flat-soled athletic shoes are required

• SLACKS | SHORTS | SKORTS

- Gentlemen shall wear golf slacks or golf shorts with a minimum 6" inseam.
- Cargo slacks or shorts (pocket on the leg) are not permitted.
- Ladies shall wear golf slacks, shorts, skorts or dresses where the minimum tailored length shall be a minimum of mid-thigh, bottoms with cargo pockets are not permitted.
- Denim is not permitted on the golf course.

• SHIRTS & TOPS

- Gentlemen must wear a collared shirt (mock necks are acceptable) and <u>must be worn always tucked in</u>. EXCEPTION: full button-down shirts (collar to hem) may be worn untucked provided they are evenly finished around the hem and designed to be worn untucked.
- Ladies shall wear shirts with or without sleeves. Sleeveless shirts must have a collar (mock necks are acceptable).

• HEADWEAR

• Caps, visors, and hats must be worn with the brim facing forward.

PROPER DRESS-

GENERAL GUIDELINES - CLUBHOUSE

- CLUBHOUSE ATTIRE
 - Golf and smart casual attire are required in the clubhouse and dining areas. This includes tailor pants, shorts, collared shirts, blouses, and appropriate footwear. Ladies must have covered midriffs.

• FOOTWEAR

Leather flip-flops or sandals are acceptable throughout the clubhouse.
Rubber flip-flops are unacceptable unless designed to be a dress sandal.
No bare feet.

• DENIM

• Appropriate denim (not ripped, torn, dirty or stonewashed) is allowed in the clubhouse only - not on the golf course or practice facilities.

• SHIRTS AND TOPS

- Gentlemen must wear a collared shirt (mock necks are acceptable) and <u>must be worn always tucked in</u>. EXCEPTION: full button-down shirts (collar to hem) may be worn untucked provided they are evenly finished around the hem and designed to be worn untucked.
- Ladies shall wear shirts with or without sleeves. Sleeveless shirts must have a collar (mock necks are acceptable).

• HEADWEAR

- Caps, visors, and hats are not permitted in the Dining Room or Spike Lounge, except for medical or religious reasons.
- DRESSES
 - Sundresses and appropriate length formal and semi-formal wear are acceptable.

PROPER DRESS-

GENERAL GUIDELINES - PROHIBITED ITEMS

The following clothing items are prohibited in all areas of the club:

- Denim jackets, tank tops, halter tops, mesh shirts, cut-offs, workout attire, spandex, yoga pants, t-shirts, rubber flip-flops, swimsuits, sweat pants, tracksuits, sheer or see-through fabrics or any undergarment type attire.
- Clothing may not display objectionable or offensive language, excessive writing and non-golf related insignias or prominent logos.

-ELECTRONICS

CELL PHONE USAGE

 Cell phones should be set to silent or vibrate mode to maintain the tranquil environment of the club. Cell phones are restricted to non-verbal forms of use when in and around the clubhouse. Talking on cellular phones is not permitted in the clubhouse and Members and Guests are also expected to step away from golf play areas including practice areas when taking calls so as not to offend or interfere with other golfers.

BLUETOOTH SPEAKERS

 The use of bluetooth speakers is permitted on the golf course, provided music is not played at a volume that other groups can hear. If you are playing music and another group can hear it, you must turn it down or turn it off. The natural environment around the course is part of the enjoyment of playing here, your music cannot negatively affect another groups golf experience. Speakers are not allowed in the Clubhouse or other common areas where they interfere with the clubs ambiance.



COURSE CARE -

At Canyon Meadows, we take immense pride in the exceptional condition of our course, which is a testament to the collective effort of our Members and Guests. Proper care of the golf course is not just a courtesy; it is central to maintaining the playability and aesthetic beauty that our club is known for. We kindly ask that during your time on course, you contribute to these efforts by diligently raking bunkers, repairing ball marks, and filling divots with the provided sand and seed mixture. This attention to detail ensures that each player who follows will enjoy the same pristine conditions that you experience.

For those utilizing golf carts, we implore you to operate them with the utmost care and respect for the course. Please keep to the designated paths where possible, especially near tees and greens, ensuring that all four wheels remain on the path in these areas. As a general rule, where pathways are not present, please keep your cart to fairways whenever possible.

PACE-OF-PLAY-

Canyon Meadows has an established a pace of play policy of 4 hours and 5 minutes or less for a foursome. It is expected that all players will play "hit when ready" golf to ensure their group does not cause any undue delay and maintains the pace guidelines. It is a group's responsibility to keep up with the group in front of them. Please choose the appropriate tees from which to play - matched to your skill level - in order to meet the pace of play guidelines.
